Cease and Desist Letter

On December 15, 2014 Chris Tutsch from Agua Flow, LLC, and member of the FWQA received a certified letter from the State, coming from the Fort Myers office stating that he was to cease and desist all advertisement of repair and replacement of pres-sure switches, pressure tanks, pumps, and plumbing connections for those products. It also stated that Aqua Flow, LLC, didn't have the proper license nor have the qualifier to advertise for these services in the state of Florida. Chris contacted the enforcement officer responsible for the letter to get an explanation, and the officer stated "Sarasota County had one of the highest rates of un-licensed workers in the state and he was determined to put a stop to it". He also told Chris he was going down the list of water treatment companies alphabetically and was sending out these cease and desist orders to them as well. Chris called me the next morning because he knew I was one of the directors for the FWQA to see if there was anything we could do. He emailed me a copy of the letter so that I could see exactly what he was referring to and I sent it out to the board members. At first we were a little hesitant to get involved, due to it was about pressure tanks and switches not water treatment. One of the board members Phil Fralix is from the Tallahassee area and he sent this email to our FWQA lobbyist (David Ram-ba) to see if there was anything we could do.

One week later I received a call from another of our members Sean Kidwell from All American Purification that had also received a cease and desist letter. It had stated that he was not properly licensed to install or work on water treatment equipment. So

once again, I sent this out to the board members and made additional calls to some of

the local water companies to get their thoughts.

The two companies that received the cease and desist notices have been in business for several years and don't deserve to have the way they conduct business or services they offer to be put in jeopardy. In addition, how many more businesses would be facing the same treatment? My hopes were that the FWQA would be able to take care of this issue before it became a larger problem. After a long day of phone calls and emails to contact someone that would listen, I received a call from Tallahassee. I was a little apprehensive not knowing if my persistence helped or made our issue worse with the cease and desist. Mr. Jerry Wilson, who works for the DEPR and is the director of code enforcement for the state of Florida, called to apologize for the letters that were issued to Sean and Chris. He continued to say they should not have been sent out and would be addressing the originating officer in Fort Myers. Mr. Jerry Wilson stated that, "My officer is doing his job but frankly over stepped his boundaries on this one. You guys are exempt from licensing and I don't think he knew that and we are sorry for the inconvenience this may have caused". He was very helpful.

We had a long talk after that about a specialty license for our trade so that we could do business without worrying about the next officer that has a different interpretation of the code and starts shutting everyone down. I explained that we do service, and install, well pumps, pressure tanks and such and that we need a license that not only covers water treatment but these things as well. I told him I don't know why it ended up this way in southern Florida, why we do work on pumps but it did and to change it now would not be good for anyone concerned (businesses or consumers). This is why we need a specialty license and he agreed. He also invited us to get involved with the legislative sessions coming up in March 2015, so any of you that would like to get involved, to see something like this happen or if you just have a comment about it, please feel free to email a board member you know or look one of us up on the FWQA web site (www.FWQA.com).

So after everything was said and done I sit back and say this is why I get involved with FWQA and for the life of me don't understand why more people in our industry are not. They came through with a victory for our industry and really don't know where I would have turned to if FWQA were not around. They really do have our backs.
